Adjustment Instructions For DYNA-KING VISES

Please note the two curved grooves in the tip of the vise jaws. These will each accommodate a different range of hook sizes. Large hooks are best held in the rear groove. Medium size hooks should be held in the groove closest to the jaw tips. Any hooks too small to be held in the grooves will be secured by the serrated section of the jaw tips, forward of the grooves.

Please be sure to RAISE THE CAM HANDLE on your vise BEFORE attempting to tighten or loosen your Forcing Cone. Failing to do so may cause damage to your vise such as, your forcing cone may become stuck locking your jaws closed & it will cause unnecessary wear on your Forcing Cone, Jaws & Cam Handle. Tension on the hook may be easily adjusted by screwing the Forcing Cone clockwise to increase tension and counterclockwise to reduce tension. Use the minimum amount of tension needed to properly secure your hook.

PLEASE DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN THE FORCING CONE.

This will cause unnecessary & excessive wear on your Forcing Cone & Jaws and may cause the Forcing Cone to become stuck.
